Scenic City Recycling Guidelines

Hello _____,

Thank you for subscribing to our service. Your collection day is: _____.

- Separation of all paper grades from other recyclables is mandatory (this includes cardboard, newspaper, junk mail, etc.)
- To ensure collection - please have your recycling receptacles out by 7:00 am, where your trash is usually collected
- Furnished receptacles are Scenic City property and are expected to be returned if service is canceled at any time. Replacement receptacles can be purchased at WalMart (18 gallon Rubbermaid Roughneck).
- **PLEASE BREAK DOWN AND FLATTEN ALL BOXES - BIG AND SMALL** (They will be left if not broken down)
- If more recyclables are collected in your household than will fit in the two receptacles that are provided, you may place them in a container or bag next to ours.
- When recycling clothes, electronics, books, ink cartridges and batteries, please bag separately and place on top of or beside recycling receptacles to ensure items are recycled properly
- Please educate entire household to increase participation and reduce contaminants

Here are a few simple guidelines to follow:

Items that WE WILL pick up:	Items that we are NOT ABLE to pick up:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glass Bottles & Jars (Green, Brown, Clear) • Plastics #1 through #7 (no styrofoam, packaging material or plastic bags unless containing other recyclables.) • Paper Milk & Juice Cartons • All paper grades (junk mail, magazines, newspapers, etc.) • Cardboard (must be broken down and flattened) • Aluminum Cans, Foil, Pie Plates (clean) • Tin Cans • Shredded Paper (in tied bags only) • Books • Clothes and gently worn shoes (cleaned, bagged and tied separately; donated to The Community Kitchen) • Computers and Small electronics (Excluding TVs, Monitors and Microwaves) • Cell Phones (Donated to Partnership for Families) • Batteries • Ink and Toner Cartridges 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic Bags & Wrappers • Window Glass • Light Bulbs • Mirrors • Ceramics • Silverware • Ovenware • Crystal • Wire Hangers • Packing Materials (Styrofoam, bubble wrap, peanuts, etc.) • Any plastic that does not have a #1 through #7 on it • Plastic Toys and Hangers • Excessively dirty or damp paper • Tissues/paper towels • Drinking Glasses
